There are many basic and applied research questions in these areas that demand a more holistic and integrative understanding, transcending the boundaries of disciplinary specialties. With its wide scope, BJoMSA will provide a platform for such work based on cross-fertilization. This will promote a greater communication among disciplines with shared problem-solving goals.

The Journal will welcome papers that are based on strong evidence, thorough analysis, and synthesis of knowledge, and which are also well-articulated to lay out the context of the research.

Our editorial team comprises distinguished experts from various parts of the world in addition to our highly motivated scholars who render in-house support. Their inspiring advice and professional help are invaluable. Reviewers who form the solid foundation of our journal's assessment system help in selecting high-quality papers for publication. Of course, authors are the ones who submit their research contributions to make publication of the Journal possible. We are thankful to all of them.

We thank the executive management of our university for reposing faith in our ability to produce this journal, the publication unit for providing assistance wherever necessary and the Journal's secretariat for intense engagement in the form of handling the difficult part of manuscript processing on a day-to-day basis. We look forward to this sort of cooperation and support from all the active players to our endeavor of developing BJoMSA to its full potential of high impact metrics.
